On behalf of the Florida Democratic Party, I hereby request complete, legible copies of the following public records, as defined in Section 119.011(12), *Florida Statutes*, from the Executive Office of the Governor:

1. Any nondisclosure agreement signed by the Governor or anyone working in the Executive Office of the Governor in connection with any meeting with the Federal Bureau of Investigation in May 2019 to discuss foreign access to voter data in 2016;
2. Any notes taken by the Governor or anyone working in the Executive Office of the Governor in connection with any meeting with the Federal Bureau of Investigation in May 2019 to discuss foreign access to voter data in 2016; and
3. Any letters, memoranda or other communications sent or received by the Governor or anyone working in the Executive Office of the Governor in connection with any meeting with the Federal Bureau of Investigation in May 2019 to discuss foreign access to voter data in 2016.

Should you deny this request, or any part thereof, please state in writing the basis for the denial, including the exact statutory citation authorizing the denial as well as the reasons for the conclusion that the record is exempt or confidential.

The Florida Democratic Party will pay the reasonable costs of assembling, copying and distributing the requested information. If the total cost is estimated to exceed \$250.00, please contact the Florida Democratic Party's General Counsel, Mark Herron, Esquire, for additional guidance before incurring those expenses.
